





VISA process for SDU (international students) Master Medical Microtechnology

- 1 The VISA duration for Denmark is dependent on the duration of registration at SDU
- 2 Students can only come to SDU as exchange student for a maximum of 2 semesters (12 months), but those can be split up in two periods.

If a student would like to stay in Denmark after the 2nd semester, it could be done like this:

- If a student wants to do the internship in 3rd semester in a Danish company, then SDU can assist in trying to find a relevant company etc., but the student should only be enrolled at TH Lübeck during this time (i.e. get the credit for the internship etc. from TH Lübeck) and the visa issues would have to be handled by the Danish company (internship host) and the student. - For the 4th semester (master thesis) in Denmark with an SDU supervisor. The student should again apply to come to SDU as an exchange student (essentially same procedure as for the 2nd semester).
- The fee for VISA processing amounts to around DKK 1,900.
- 4 Regarding the amount needed to have in the account, it should be sufficient documentation for the same account that students use for the German VISA. They must be able to support themselves and document that they have an amount corresponding to DKK 6,243 each month.
- 5 If all documents are ready when applying for a VISA, it takes approx. 6 weeks to get it.

- The application deadline for exchange students is 1 October (for non-EU citizens) and 1

 November (for EU citizens) in order to start here in the Spring semester in February of the following year.
